College has footy wins

STUDENTS at Mazenod College have had a stellar season in the Swan Districts Junior Football District competition.

This year the school's Year 7 and Year 12 footy teams took out the grand finals in the competition, which includes teams from Mazenod, Kalamunda, Bassendean, Darlington-Parkerville, La Salle, High Wycombe, Chittering and Eastern Hills.

Health and physical education head Chris Bolton said the Yr 7s were involved in a round robin competition throughout the year and were coached by Adrian Conti and Grayden Leaver.

Following the regular season, the teams competed in a knock out competition, where the

Yr 7 Mazenod College team 13.13 (91) to 2.13 (15) defeated Darlington-Parkerville in the grand final.

Bolton said the best players were Matt Russo, Adam Disisto and Michael Garfield.

Matt Russo was awarded the best on ground award after kicking a match winning 9 goals during the game.

The Year 11-12 team went through the 2012 season having only lost two games.

"They were captained exceptionally well by Luka Swithenbank and his deputies Dean Munns, Cameron Sermon and Brandon Truss throughout the season," he said.

Bolton said he and Nathan Drudi had

coached the boys to consecutive premierships in the 15s and the 17s recording 34 wins and four losses in two seasons.

Mazenod played their best game of the season, eventually running out 50-point winners over their opposition.

The final score was Mazenod 12.8 (80) to Bassendean 4.6 (30).
