\$15,500 raised for Kenya

MAZENOD College's Mission Day exceeded expectations, raising more than \$15,500 to help build infrastructure in a Kenyan community.

The students' stalls, which ranged from pizzas and burgers to basketball competitions, were a hit at the all-day event held last month.

School spokeswoman Nickie Opechowski said donations were still trickling in.

She said the school wanted to try something a bit different with this year's fundraiser.

"Traditionally, every year students participate in a mission fun run during term three, which is the primary fundraising event for the college to help raise necessary funds for Oblate missions around the world.

"This year, however the event comprised of not only sporting activities, but a whole day event, to be known as Mazenod Mission Day."
